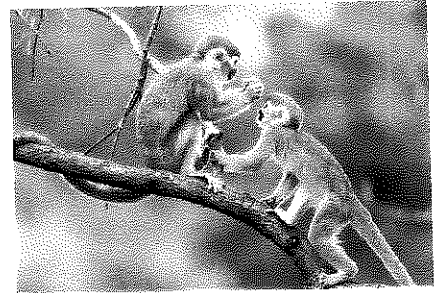
The Amazon Rainforest

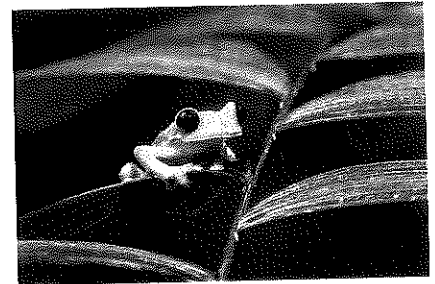

Rainforests are warm, wet, lush **habitats** that contain many different **species** or kinds of plants and animals. Rainforests can be found all over the world, but the largest tropical rainforest is the Amazon Rainforest in South America. It covers over 1.4 billion acres. Scientists estimate that more than ten percent of the world's animals live in the Amazon rainforest. They also believe that there are 2.5 million different species of insects and over 40,000 different species of plants that live there. The Amazon Rainforest is home to animals such as jaguars, monkeys, sloths, frogs, snakes, and more!
