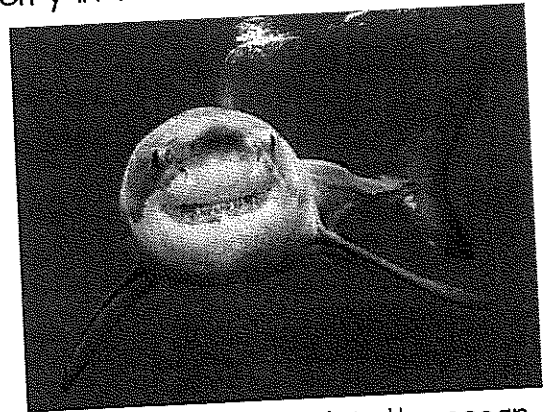
All About Sharks

The water of the ocean appears empty. Nothing seems to be moving or swimming in the water. Suddenly, and silently, a dark shape looms in the distance. A shark swims silently into the area, hunting for its dinner.

Sharks have long scared humans. Many shark species have rows and rows of sharp teeth that they use to eat their prey. They also have a great sense of smell and can smell blood from miles around. Even though they appear scary to many people, they are actually an important part of the ocean's ecosystem.

Sharks are known as an **apex predators**. This means they are on the top of the food chain and don't have any natural predators. As apex predators, sharks help keep the balance and diversity in the ocean's ecosystem. They help remove the weak and sick animals as well as keep ocean animal populations in balance. If sharks are removed from an area, other fish explode in population. This can affect coral reefs and other animals in the food chain. Sharks are important ocean animals!

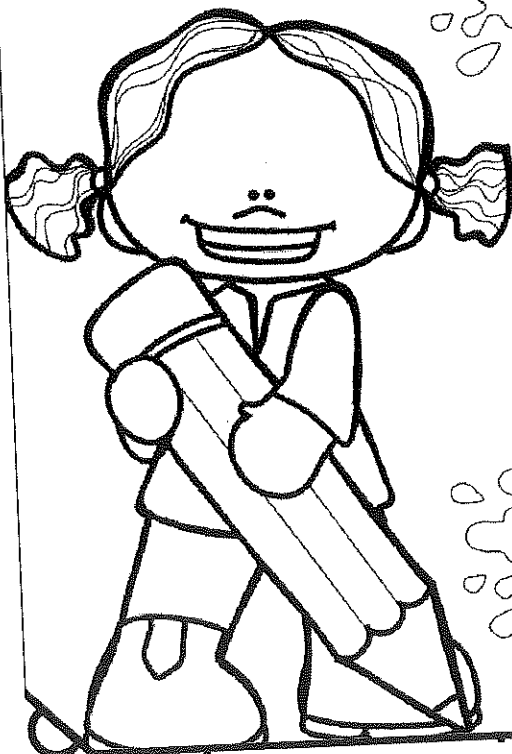
