What is a force?


A force is a push or a pull. If you push or pull something, a force is being applied. Forces make things move, change their speed, shape, or motion. For example, when wind pushes a sailboat through the water, a force is being applied. When gravity pulls an apple toward the ground, a force is being applied. When a magnet pulls a paperclip toward it, a force is being applied.

Gravity is a type of force that pulls objects toward each other. That's why we aren't floating in the air trying to walk! Gravity pulls us toward the ground. It is also the force that keeps the earth revolving around the sun.


Magnetism is another type of force that pushes or pulls magnetic objects. If two matching ends are put next to each other, they push each other apart. If two opposite ends are put next to each other, the pull together. This is a type of force!
