

Snow Day Instruction Guidelines

Implementation Guidelines

Our snow day work will be implemented as follows:

1. Parents will receive a Remind 101 alert stating: “SSM will be closed today due to inclement weather. Please go to Weebly to find your instructions (website link included).” The principal will take into consideration multiple situations to determine if the snow day will be an alternative plan day or not. For example: no consecutive alternative plan days, first “big” snow day will not be assigned – have the students have fun outside, etc.). If no work will be assigned, and a “snow day given” it will be stated on Remind.
2. Archdiocesan Policy allows a maximum of 5 alternative plan days.
3. Attendance for the school day is determined from returned completed work. Please call the office if your student is sick.
4. Teachers will be available to their students each day between the hours of 9 AM and 2 PM. Feel free to email them with questions about the work. Individual teachers may expand their available time.

Kindergarten through 4th Grade will be given a snow packet to complete prior to inclement weather. We believe technology may be limited and more of a “hassle” for parents & students in those grade levels. K- 4 students will complete a packet of work for each day that is identified as an alternative workday.

Students in grades 5 – 8 will access their work through the Weebly and Google Classroom as they usually would at school. The work will be posted by 9am on the given alternative workday. The students will have 3 days to complete the work online. If technology is an issue that day, please just communicate with teachers.

5. All work will be due on the third calendar business days after the snow event. For example, if school is cancelled on a Tuesday, the work is due by Friday. If school is cancelled on a Friday, the work is due the following Wednesday. However, we strongly encourage children to complete the work on their day off.
6. Zeroes will be given, and an absence will be recorded if the work is not turned in by the third calendar day.
7. We understand that most families have only one computer. In the case of a predicted and extended inclement weather, we will send technology home with students in grades 5 - 8.
8. If weather conditions are severe enough to disrupt electrical power or displace families, exceptions to the above steps may be granted.
